

Slow/no wake still in effect

Water levels on the Rock River are dropping, but authorities reminded boaters Wednesday that slow/no wake orders are still in effect.

Signs have been posted along the river and at public access points across the county since March 22, according to a news release from the Rock County Sheriff's Office.

Water levels have been receding, authorities said, but are still well above levels that trigger slow/no wake orders, based on a Rock County ordinance.

Lake Koshkonong is at 8.34 feet, while the river is 7.22 feet in Afton, according to the news release.

Slow/no wake orders are required when Lake Koshkonong tops 7.5 feet and the river reaches over 6.5 feet at Afton, authorities said.
