Slow-No-Wake Declared on Rock River

According to U.S. Geological Survey Gauges, the water level in Afton is 8.66 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the Rock River downstream of the West Beloit Rock Town Line Road Bridge when water levels exceed 8.50 feet in Afton.

The Sheriff's Office is providing public notice of the Rock River's current slow-no-wake status. Deputies will begin placing slow-no-wake signs along the river at all public access points between the West Beloit Rock Town Line Road Bridge and the Stateline.

At this time the entire Rock River is under a slow-no wake restriction. Lake Koshkonong is exempt from the slow-no-wake restriction.
