We do not have facilities to handle or store hazardous waste except at events listed on front. Attach this brochure to storage area as a reminder to save items for Clean Sweep.

Clean Sweep is held every year.

## **Business Program - Rock County**

Businesses must use business program.

Any WI business, school or agency that generates less than 2,200 pounds of hazardous wastes per year may be eligible to use Clean Sweep for cost of disposal and no vendor mobilization costs.

For year-round service, contact Dane County Business Clean Sweep (above).

Latex paint (water-based/water clean-up) – Make solid. Air-dry or stir in kitty litter, Oil-Dri, or any highly absorbent material. When paint is hard, put with trash, can lids OFF. Liquid paint in trash is not good for handlers and equipment.

Latex paint recycling - Ace Hardware in Janesville, Beloit. Small fee per gallon. Call ahead. Hardened non-lead, non-metallic paints, varnishes - Remove lids, place with trash.

Recycle Year Round! Many local businesses accept the items below in LIMITED QUANTITIES for free or a small fee. CALL AHEAD.

- **Earth911.com** Extensive list of recyclable items, search by ZIP code for local options.
- Recycler list (small volume) at Rock County Clean Sweep website or by request (754-6617 ext, 3)

**BATTERIES** - tape over contacts. DO NOT STOCKPILE batteries due to fire risk.

Rechargeable and all Lithium batteries (NiCd, NiMH, Li Ion, Li Poly) - Call2recycle.org lists several local dropboxes. Batteries Plus. Usually free. Alkaline batteries

- Mercury-free since 1996 and not banned from WI landfills. "Trash can" symbol is for landfill bans elsewhere. Earth911.com lists mail-in programs. Batteries Plus accepts, fee per lb.

**Vehicle batteries:** Auto service, supply, or salvage, check recyclers in phone book. Often free.

**Used motor oil:** check with city/town waste hauler, auto service/supply stores. Usually free, 1-gallon limit, some take up to 5 gallons. Call ahead.

*Oil filters:* Check Earth911, some auto service/supply stores, check with city waste service. Call ahead.

**Antifreeze:** Some auto service/supply, check with city – call ahead. Clean Sweep limit.

Fluorescent bulbs: hardware/home improvement stores, Batteries Plus. Rates and accepted bulb types vary by store; CFLs usually free. Call ahead. Lamp ballasts – Lappin Electric. Call for rate/lb. Electronics, computers, printers — URT, Goodwill, electronics stores, more at Earth911. Check with your

Fire extinguishers: call local fire safety suppliers.

#### What should I know?

- Advance registration required.
- NO LATEX PAINT! (see next page)
- Fees and limits may apply.
- Recycle motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze (see next page or recycling flyer)
- No lamp ballasts (see next page)

#### Accepted Materials:

- Herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, and rodenticides
- DDT; silvex; heptachlor; dieldrin; lindane; toxaphene; and 2,4,5-T
- Acids (sulfuric, muriatic, hydrochloric) and strong bases
- Solvents (ketone, acetone, turpentine, mineral spirits)
- All lead paint (banned in 1978)
- All metallic paint
- Liquid paints, varnishes, lacquers, stains that require solvents for thinning or clean-up
- Photographic chemicals
- Lye
- · Pool and spa chemicals, bleaches
- Wood and paint strippers (methyl chloride, others)
- Wood treatments containing penta, creosote, or arsenic
- · Deck stains and driveway sealers.
- Dairy acids
- · General farm chemicals
- Old fuel
- Motor oil contaminated with water, antifreeze, fuel
- Hydraulic fluids
- Lighter fluids, charcoal lighter, kerosene
- Mercury thermometers, thermostats, switches, dimmers, manometers. Leave devices intact.
- Broken fluorescent bulbs packed airtight.

**Unknown Chemicals**: Accepted in quantities less than 50 pounds or 5 gallons. For larger amounts of unknown chemicals, call 754-6617 ext. 118.

Drums, mini-bulks, other containers that need forklift to unload – CALL 754-6617 ext. 118. For disposal of empty pesticide barrels and mini-bulks, contact Container Services Network (CSN) at 866-225-6629.

#### Clean Sweep cannot accept:

High pressure cylinders, propane cylinders, Freon gases, infectious and biological wastes, sharps, explosives (detonators, blasting caps, ammunition), radioactive chemicals / devices.

#### **SAFETY First!**

- 1. Read labels for proper use, warnings, and storage.
- 2. Protect your eyes, lungs, and skin.
- 3. Store items away from children and pets.
- 4. Avoid stockpiling hazardous materials.
- 5. DO NOT mix chemicals.
- 6. Do not reuse hazardous waste containers.
- 7. Place fragile packages in separate containers and label "Hazardous!" *Use clear bags*.

# Buying, storage, & disposal tips

- Read labels in the store for proper use, warnings, and storage:
- 2. Consider your project timeline, product shelf-life.
- Store materials properly. Avoid extreme temperatures and damp areas that can rust storage containers. Seal lids with care so products do not dry out, evaporate, or spill.
- 4. Never pour chemicals down the drain (you could damage plumbing, septic system, or wastewater facility).
- Recycle or responsibly dispose of wastes as soon as possible. Large amounts of waste can be a health, fire, or environmental hazard.
